Lesson Plan

Topic: Simple Future – The use of Will

[Sub-Topic: Using the Simple Future to describe future predictions]

Assumptions of Previous Knowledge: Students are expected to have basic understanding of English sentence structure (subject + verb + complement) and to recognize some common verbs in their base form (go, study, work).

Instructional Goals:

- To develop students' reading comprehension skills through the analysis of images with short descriptions.
- To expand students' vocabulary related to future actions, promises and predictions.
- To promote oral and written communication in English through group discussions and writing activities.





- If (condition)



+ will + verb + complement

I will
You will
She will
He will
It will
We will
They will

✓ Affirmative

Subject + will

I **will** study
after class.

✗ Negative

Subject + will
+ not

I **will not** study
after class.
→ **won't**
