3. Student A interviews Student B, pretending to be a celebrity.

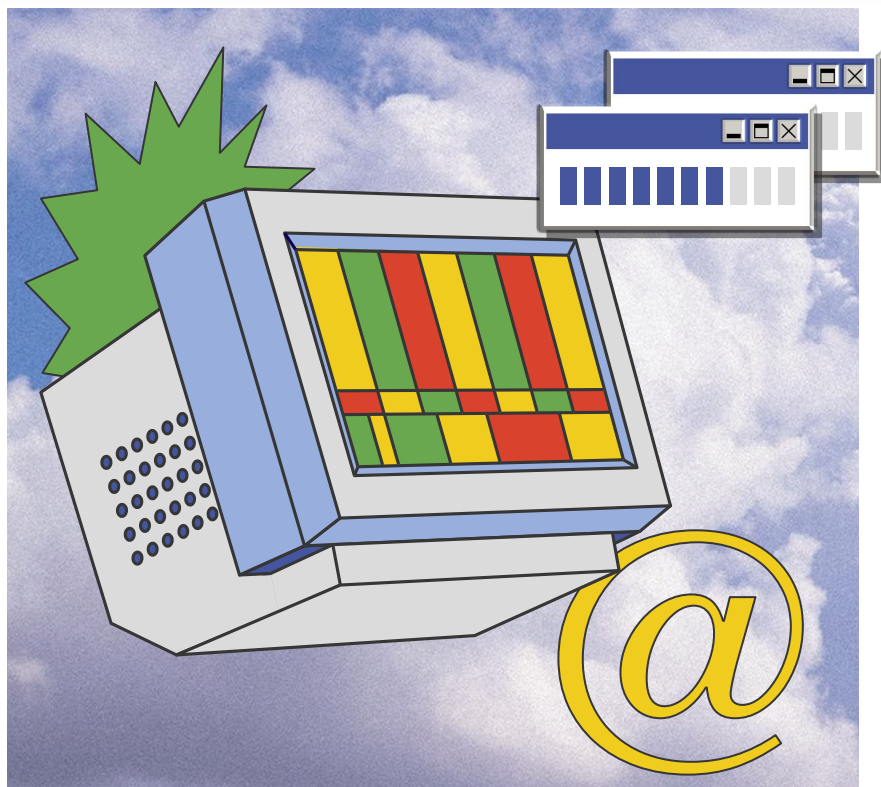


Instructions

When you were children, would you have liked to receive a letter from someone older giving you advice about life?

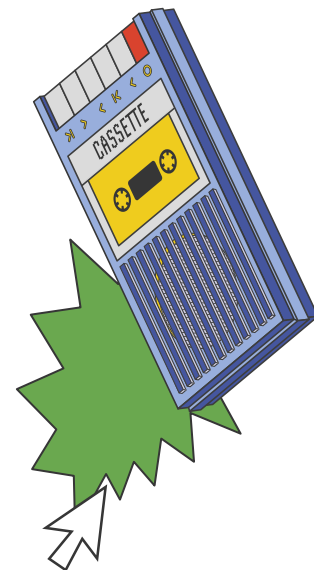
Let's make a letter!
